### Whoever is Angry... • Matthew 5:21-26

<sup>21</sup>You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgment.' <sup>22</sup>But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

<sup>23</sup>So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, <sup>24</sup>leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. <sup>25</sup>Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are going with him to court, lest your accuser hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you be put in prison. <sup>26</sup>Truly, I say to you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny. Matthew 5:21-26 (ESV)

#### A Prayer of Examination:

**RECALL:** Think through key events and emotions of your day or week. Ask God to reveal thoughts, desires, words, and actions that fell short and expressed ungodly anger. (Psalm 139:23-24)

**REPENT:** Wherever you see words, thoughts, desires, and actions in your life that don't look like Jesus: confess, receive His grace, and ask for His Spirit to empower you. (1 John 1:9)

**RENEW:** With hope, consider tomorrow. Ask God for wisdom, strength, and boldness to walk in the His ways. (1 Corinthians 10:13, Lamentations 3:22-23)
