Your Kingdom Come • Matthew 6:10

#1. Jesus teaches us to pray with a new FOCUS.

The Kingdom of God is every place where God is honored as King, bringing people, the creation, and relationships in alignment with Him.

²⁰Being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, he answered them, “The kingdom of God is not coming in ways that can be observed, ²¹nor will they say, ‘Look, here it is!’ or ‘There!’ for behold, the kingdom of God is in the midst of you.” Luke 17:20-21 (ESV)

Praying “Your kingdom come, your will be done,” is praying that God would use my LIFE and INFLUENCE to manifest His Kingdom.

#2. Jesus’ prayer invites us to ALIGN our lives with His Kingdom work.

From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”
Matthew 4:17 (ESV)
