The Parable of the Wedding Feast • Luke 14:7-11

Takeaway #1: Even the most mundane actions of life can reveal something deep about our hearts.

Now he told a parable to those who were invited, when he noticed how they chose the places of honor... (Luke 14:7)

Takeaway #2: Honor is not defined by man, but always defined by God.

⁸ “When you are invited by someone to a wedding feast, do not sit down in a place of honor, lest someone more distinguished than you be invited by him, ⁹ and he who invited you both will come and say to you, ‘Give your place to this person,’ and then you will begin with shame to take the lowest place. (Luke 14:8-9)

Takeaway #3: There is no honor in God’s Kingdom for us unless we begin with humility.

But when you are invited, go and sit in the lowest place, so that when your host comes he may say to you, ‘Friend, move up higher.’ Then you will be honored in the presence of all who sit at table with you. (Luke 14:10)

BIG TAKEAWAY: The Kingdom of God is opposed to the proud, and yet wide open to all who humble themselves before Jesus.
